SUBJECT: Ordinance Amendment Concerning the Ann Land
& Bertha Henschel Memorial Funds Commission

SUMMARY

The present City ordinance creating the Ann Land and Bertha Henschel Memorial Funds Commission designates the City Manager as the President. The proposed amendment would allow the Commission to elect their own President.

BACKGROUND

Section 2.33 dealing with establishment and composition of the Ann Land and Bertha Henschel Commission would be changed by deleting the wording which is crossed out and adding the sentences underlined as follows:

There is hereby created a commission to be known and designated as the "Ann Land and Bertha Henschel Memorial Funds Commission." The commission shall consist of the city manager, who shall ~~be president thereof;~~ be an ex officio member with full voting rights, and twelve other members, who shall be residents of the city and who shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the city council. The commission shall elect a president from among its members who shall hold office at the pleasure of the commission.

FINANCIAL DATA

There is no cost in view of the fact that the City Manager has never had business cards or stationery printed bearing his title "MR. PRESIDENT."

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the proposed ordinance amendment be passed and later adopted.

ORDINANCE NO. 4458 FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SACRAMENTO CITY CODE SECTION 2.33 RELATING TO THE ANN LAND AND BERTHA HENSCHEL MEMORIAL FUNDS COMMISSION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Section 2.33 of Chapter 2 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 2.33 Establishment; composition.

There is hereby created a commission to be known and designated as the "Ann Land and Bertha Henschel Memorial Funds Commission." The commission shall consist of the city manager, who shall be an ex officio member with full voting rights, and twelve other members, who shall be residents of the city and who shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the city council. The commission shall elect a president from among its members who shall hold office at the pleasure of the commission.
