ORDINANCE NO. 1195, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THAT CERTAIN PUBLIC WORK BE DONE BY THE CITY WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

WHEREAS, the City Manager of the City of Sacramento has recommended that the following described work be done by the City without first advertising for bids,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The City Council hereby directs and authorizes that the following described public work shall be done by the City without first advertising for bids.

SECTION 2: The work to be done is described as follows:

- (a) The furnishing of materials, painting and carpenter work on two (2) toilet buildings at Camp Sacramento.
- (b) The furnishing of materials and plumbing work on two (2) toilet buildings at Camp Sacramento.
- (c) The installation of one septic tank.
- (d) The installation of evaporation beds.
- (e) The construction of foundations for army truck bodies to be used as store rooms.

All of the above work and materials to cost not more than \$5000.00.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure to take effect immediately; such emergency being that it is necessary that this work be started immediately in order that it may be completed before weather conditions prevent.
