

Resolution of Intention No. 3247

Pursuant to a law of the State of California, known as Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, the "Improvement Act of 1911."

It is hereby resolved that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Sacramento to order the following work of improvement to be done, to-wit:

The improvement of the following in the City of Sacramento:

McGlashan Street, Bonniemae Way, 46th Street and 25th Avenue as the same are shown and designated on the Plat of Fruitridge Oaks Unit No. 7, as the same is recorded in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder; Perry Avenue from the Westerly line of Stockton Boulevard to the Northerly production of the Westerly Boundary of said Fruitridge Oaks Unit No. 7;

Improving Right of Ways in said Fruitridge Oaks Unit No. 7 as follows: Along the Northerly line of Lots 410, 432, 458 and 478; Along the rear of Lots 417 to 439 both inclusive; Along the rear of Lots 440 to 466 both inclusive; Along the rear of Lots 467 to 476 both inclusive and Lots 478 and 479; Along the Southerly line of Lot 476;

by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; constructing concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks; installing cast-iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified clay sewer pipe; constructing vitrified clay pipe sewer; constructing concrete manholes complete with cast-iron frames and covers; removing concrete slab, trees, and concrete curb and gutter where shown on Plan; constructing a water distribution system, complete; grading and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement.

All of said work to be done in accordance with the "Standard Specifications of the City of Sacramento" heretofore adopted by the City Council and also in accordance with detailed Plans and Special Provisions made therefore by the City Engineer and on file in his office having been approved by the City Council on March 13th, 1958; and

WHEREAS said City Council has found and determined that pursuant to Section 2804 of Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, the Owners of more than 60% of the Area of the property subject to Assessment for the above described improvement, have signed and

filed with the City Clerk a written petition and said Owners did in said petition WAIVE the proceedings, required by the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931", and the said City Council does hereby approve of said WAIVER and resolves to commence proceedings as provided in Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, THE IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 1911.

And whereas, in the opinion of said City Council said work is of more than local and ordinary public benefit, said Council hereby orders that the costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be chargeable and charged upon a district of lands, which district is hereby declared to be the district benefited by said work and improvement and which is to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof.

The exterior boundaries of said district and the extent of the territory included therein are shown upon the map of said district adopted and approved by the City Council on March 13th, 1958, which map is now on file in the office of the City Engineer and to which reference is hereby made for a particular description of the boundaries of said district and of the extent of the territory included therein;

Saving and excepting from the above bounden and described district the area of all public streets, alleys, ways, boulevards, courts and avenues included therein.

Notice is hereby given that serial bonds to represent unpaid assessments and bear interest at the rate of five (5%) per cent per annum will be issued hereunder in the manner provided by the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," the last installment of which bonds shall mature fourteen (14) years from the second day of July next succeeding ten (10) months from their date.

All persons objecting to said work, or to the extent of said assessment district, are required to file their objections in writing in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Sacramento, as required by law, and notice is hereby given to all persons interested that on the 3rd day of April, 1958 at 7:30 o'clock p.m. in the Council Chamber of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, in the City Hall, on "I" Street, between 9th and 10th Streets, in said City, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work and improvement may appear before said City Council and show cause why the proposed work and improvement shall not be carried out in accordance with this Resolution.

And the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution twice in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by law.
