2. Landscape Planting and Irrigation shall be approved by the City Landscape Architect and shall be maintained by the permittee.

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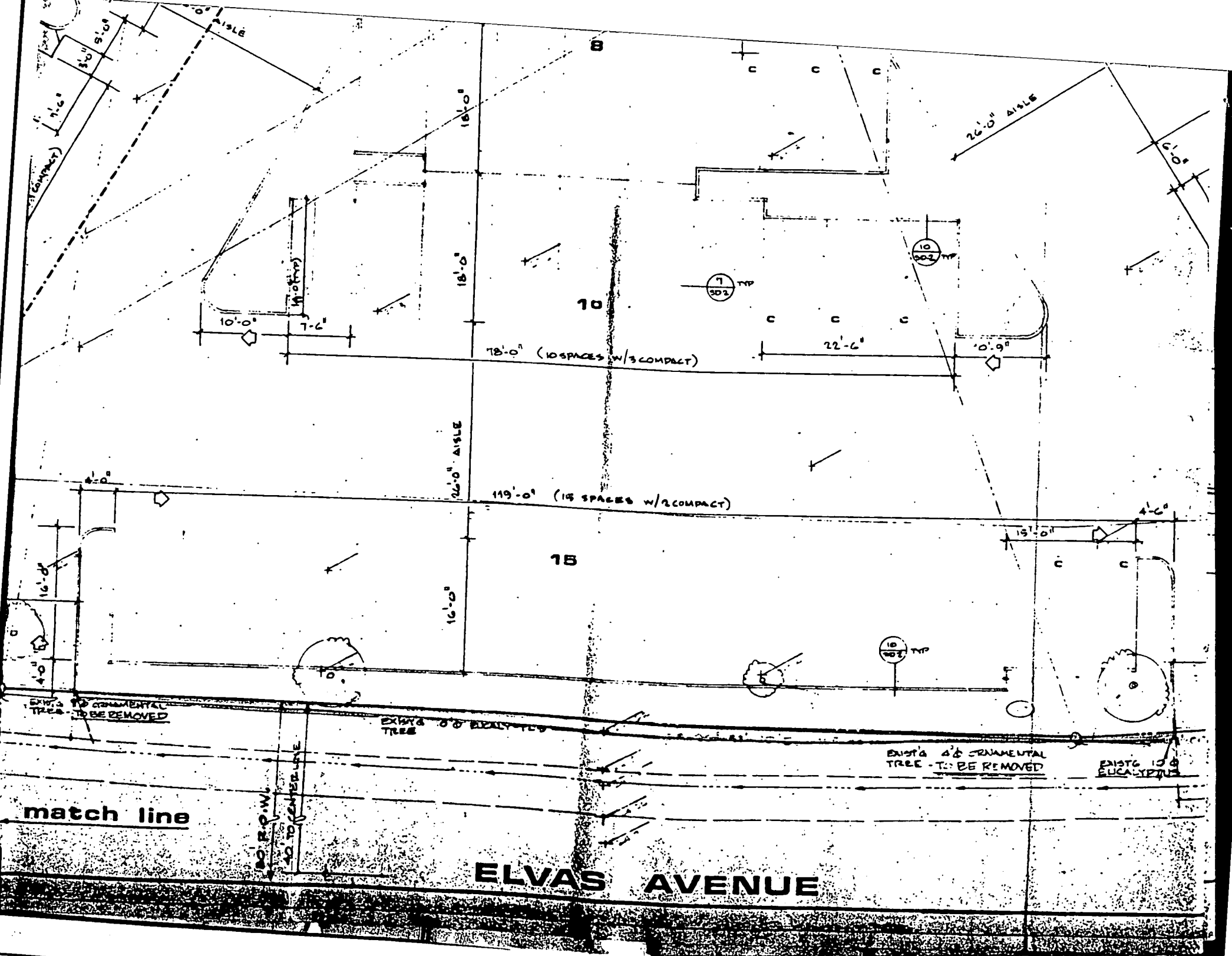
