

MINUTES OF CIVIL SERVICE BOARD
CITY OF SACRAMENTO
SPECIAL MEETING

March 7, 1956

The Civil Service Board met in special session at 4:30 P.M.

PRESENT: Commissioners Deise, Finks and Wright


ABSENT : None

Councilmen Leslie Wood, James B. McKinney, Murle C. Shreck, Civil Service Committee of the City Council, and B. W. Cavanaugh, City Manager, met with the Civil Service Board at a special meeting held for the purpose of discussion of possible salary increases for the budget year 1956-57.

Mr. Cavanaugh explained that, if possible, the administration would like to have an indication of the amount of salary increases being considered by the Board in order to facilitate preparation of the budget.

Informal discussion followed and two members of the Civil Service Board - Messrs. Wright and Deise indicated that in their opinion a one and one-half step increase for all monthly salaried employees would probably be justified. The third member of the Board, Mr. Finks, indicated that he could not make any decision until he had had an opportunity to study the salary survey data and to hear various employee representatives.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned at 6 P.M. to meet again at the Call of the Chair.
