REQUEST TO COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO REGARDING LOCATION OF SOCIAL SERVICES PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES

WHEREAS, social service programs and facilities serving the general population of the County of Sacramento tend to be concentrated in the ~~City of~~ City of the City of Sacramento and other City neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, residents and businesses in the vicinity of sites which are proposed for the location of social service programs and facilities should have a meaningful opportunity to participate in the process of the consideration and approval of such sites.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The City of Sacramento hereby requests that the County of Sacramento not fund additional social service programs (including homeless and mental health services that are, or would be, located in the ~~City of~~ City (~~05944 and 05945 to 7412~~) ~~and~~ ~~high-concentration neighborhoods~~, until the County has adopted a Fair Share Policy to distribute such services more equitably throughout the County of Sacramento. The City of Sacramento Staff working with the County, shall prepare a needs assessment that identifies the level of need for social services, by type (e.g. Food, shelter, mental health, etc), in the City and County. This analysis shall also identify the level of need by planning areas within the City.

Section 2. The City of Sacramento staff is directed to work with the County of Sacramento to develop a comprehensive and updated inventory of social services (including group homes serving six or fewer persons) by location, type of service delivered, and number of persons served in consultation with the State of California Department of Social Services and the Community Services Planning Council.

Section 3. The City of Sacramento requests that the County of Sacramento incorporate good neighbor conditions in all of its social service provider contracts, including the contracts for providers at the Social Service Complex in the Richards Boulevard Redevelopment

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Project Area.

Section 4. The City of Sacramento requests that the County of Sacramento adopt a notice and hearing process that will give to neighbors of a proposed social service program site an opportunity to be heard on the proposal and which will consider such neighborhood input before selection and approval of the site is finalized.

Section 5. Based on the needs analysis and the inventory of existing ~~needs~~ ^{sites} for the City, the City staff shall identify adequate sites with sufficient zoning to meet unmet needs for social services. City staff shall develop reasonable locational criteria to ensure that such sites are distributed fairly throughout the city + County

Section 6. City staff shall work with the County to develop, based on the needs assessment and the inventory of sites, a fair share distribution policy for County funding for social services.

Section 7. The City of Sacramento staff is directed to report back for Council adoption by November 16, 1999, with proposed review procedures and development standards for the siting and integration of homeless, mental health and social service care facilities ~~at the end of 1999 with additional locational criteria concurrently with the needs assessment and fair share policies described below.~~ *unrealistic.*

Section 8. The City Clerk shall deliver a copy of this resolution to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento.
