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The Honorable City Council met in Special Session on this date at hour of 8.45 o'clock P. M., Mayor Elkus presiding and Roll Call was answered by following members of the City Council:

Call for the meeting which stated purpose to be the award or rejection of bids on proposed Municipal Auditorium was read and ordered filed.

Upon recommendation of City Manager on this date which was ordered filed, Councilman Kiernan moved that Contract for Plumbing in the Municipal Auditorium be awarded to Latourrette-Fical Company, Sacramento, in sum of \$24,500.00 less cost of corporate surety bonds, in place of which personal surety bonds suitable to the Controller are hereby authorized in accordance with plans and specifications adopted August 13th, 1925 and bid submitted September 17th, 1925, (1923 Municipal Improvement Bond Fund) and that all other bids thereon be rejected and certified checks returned. Seconded by Councilman Frazier and carried by following vote:



The City Attorney was thereupon directed to prepare necessary contracts and bonds for foregoing work.


