The Honorable City Council met in Special Session on this date at hour of 8.10 o'clock P. M.

Call for the Meeting which stated purpose thereof to be the consideration of the 1926 Budget was ordered filed.

The Budget presented by City Manager on date of August 10th, 1925 was thereupon discussed at considerable length.

City Manager reported a correction to be made on Page 19 of the Budget providing for Water Mains Division, changing the salary of Caulkers from \$4.615 to \$5.00.

Councilman Kiernan addressed Council stating that appropriation providing for salaries of two assistants in the City Pound could be expended to better advantage otherwise and moved that same be eliminated and items of \$600.00 fees for the Department be added. Seconded by Councilman Anderson and lost by following vote:
