

ORDINANCE NO. 1117, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING  
A PORTION OF 9TH AVENUE IN THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That a portion of 9TH AVENUE,  
in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of  
California, described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot  
72 of "Amended Plat of Ellwood" (as the same  
is shown on the official map thereof filed in  
the office of the County Recorder of the County  
of Sacramento, State of California), thence  
from the point of beginning S 89° 39' W 205.00  
feet along the northerly line of said Lot 72 to  
the northwest corner thereof; thence north 54.00  
feet to the southwest corner of Lot 1 of said "Amended  
Plat of Ellwood"; thence N 89° 39' E 55.25 feet along  
the south line of Lots 1 and 2 of said "Amended Plat  
of Ellwood" to a point; thence by a curve to the right  
having a radius of 78.00 feet and whose chord bears  
S 41° 35.84' E 262 feet to a point; thence by a curve  
to the left having a radius of 134.04 feet and whose  
chord bears S 65° 34.73' E 112.25 feet to a point;  
thence N 49° 39' E 45.80 feet along a line parallel  
to and distant 5.00 feet northerly from the northerly  
line of said Lot 72; thence S 0° 02.56' E 5.00 feet  
to the point of beginning,

is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.

RESERVING, however, the right of entry to repair, main-  
tain and construct sewer, water pipe, gas pipe and aerial  
or underground power, telephone and other communication fac-  
ilities now in place in said street, or which, from time to  
time, may be necessary to be placed therein.

Said closing and vacating is declared after due  
proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by  
the City Council, which is hereby made, that said street  
herein described is unnecessary for present or prospective  
public street purposes.
