


ORDINANCE NO. 967, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE THE NECESSARY MATERIAL TO DIM OUT THE WINDOWS OF THE CITY LIBRARY WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.


SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in open market, without first advertising for bids, the necessary material to dim out the windows of the City Library, in the manner required by Ordinance No. 966, Fourth Series (Dim-out ordinance), at a cost not to exceed \$1,000.00, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that, under the dim-out ordinance passed by the City Council in pursuance of direction of Lieutenant General De Witt of the United States Army, dim-out shall be accomplished by November 12 1942, and it is necessary that this material be purchased immediately.
