SUBJECT: LAGOMARSINO WAY DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT, (PN:XM34) AWARD CONTRACT TO SPINELLA HEER CONSTRUCTION, INC., FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$146,521.

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

The Lagomarsino Way Drainage Improvement Project is located in Council District 3. See location map.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council accept the bid from Spinella Heer Construction, Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$146,521 and award the contract.

SUMMARY

On June 22, 1998, the Lagomarsino Way Drainage Improvement Project was advertised for bids. Bids were received from four (4) contractors and opened by the City Clerk on July 15, 1998. Spinella Heer Construction, Inc., is the low bidder at \$146,521.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- This project is located on Lagomarsino Way between D Street and C Street and on C Street between Lagomarsino Way and 51st Street. The existing combined sewer system is inadequate and causes flooding problems during the rainy season.
- On Lagomarsino Way between D Street and Aileen Way, approximately 230 linear feet of 8" and 10" combined sewer main will be replaced with a 15" combined sewer main. On Lagomarsino Way between Aileen Way and C Street, approximately 260 linear feet of 15" combined sewer main will be placed. On C Street, approximately 560 linear feet of 15" combined sewer main will be placed. This includes placing and replacing approximately seven (7) manholes, 200 linear feet of drain lead, six (6) drainage inlets, six (6) sewer services, and constructing four (4) handicap ramps.

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$155,650. The estimated completion date is September 30, 1998.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The total estimated cost for this project, including all design, construction, inspection and administration is \$205,400. The current budget for this project is \$300,000 in the Sewer/Drainage Fund Capital Improvement Program (425/414-500-XM34).

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

The Environmental Services Division has determined that this project is categorically exempt pursuant to State Class 1 and 2 and Section Number 15302(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act.

POLICY CONSIDERATION

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.304 of the City Code concerning award of contracts.



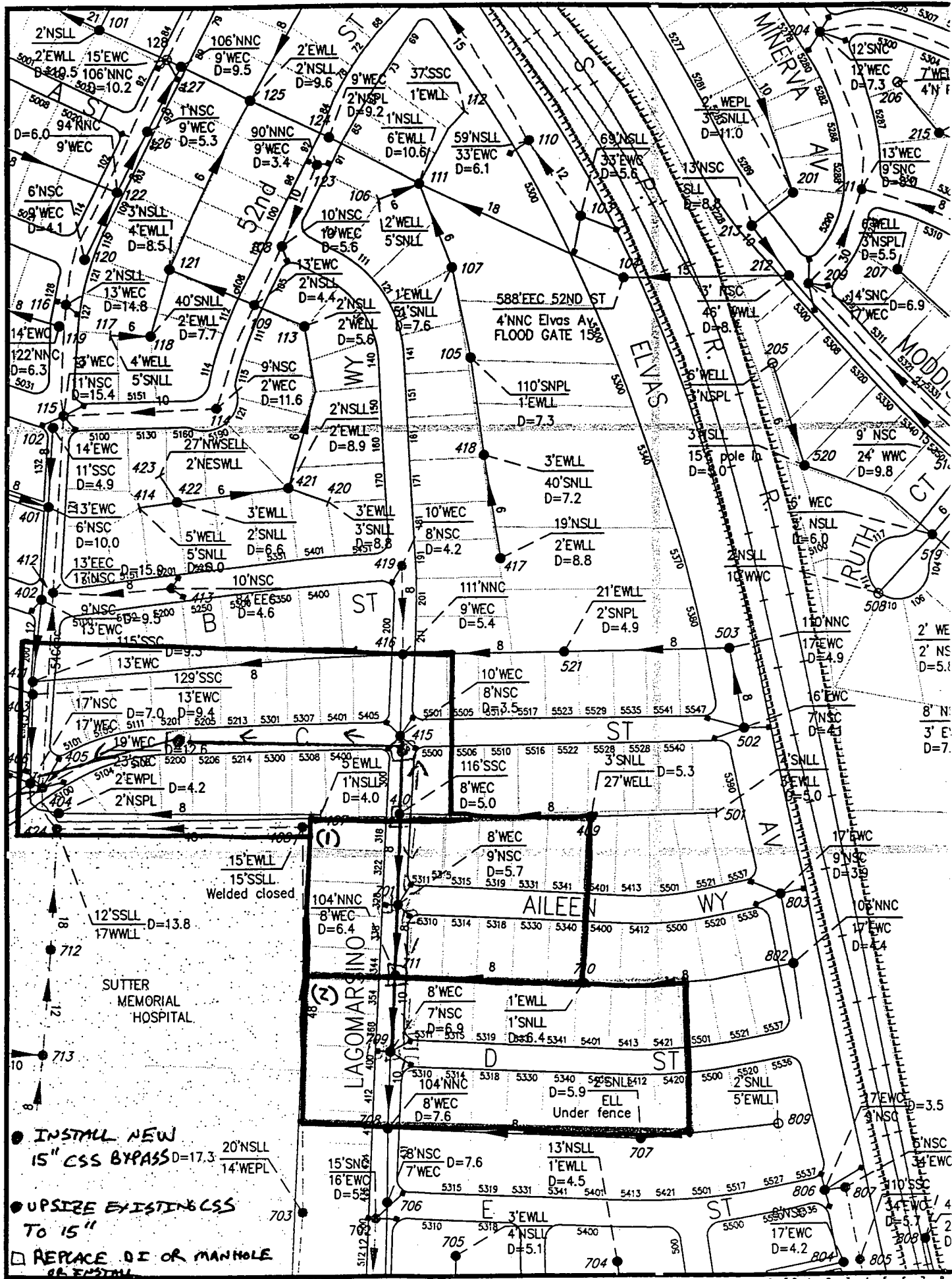

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

5TH Street between H and I Streets and H Street between 5th and 6th Streets. Council District 1.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Accept the plans and specifications;
- Reject all bids;
- Adopt the attached resolution suspending competitive bidding, and approval of a fund appropriation in the amount of \$154,000 to the 5th and H Streets Reconstruction Project;
- Award contract to Environmental Construction for the 5th and H Street Reconstruction Project.

SUMMARY:

This project is the second phase of street improvements around the new Federal Courthouse. This project will reconstruct 5th Street between H and I Streets and H Street between 5th and 6th Streets and place an overlay on I Street between 5th and 6th Streets. The street improvements include construction of pavement, curb, gutter, sidewalk, street lighting, and combined storm drainage and sewer system. The California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) has approved a \$40,000 grant to utilize Rubberized Asphalt Concrete (RAC) around the Federal Courthouse.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- This project was authorized in the 1997/1998 Capital Improvement Program.
- This project was advertised and bids were received on April 21, 1998, and are summarized below:

- Environmental Construction met the MBE goal but did not meet the WBE goal, and did not perform a good faith effort. Environmental Construction is a minority-owned business certified with the City of Sacramento.
- The construction estimate is \$637,712.
- It is recommended, in the best interest of the City, to reject all bids, suspend competitive bidding and award the contract to Environmental Construction.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction, and construction engineering costs, is \$881,244.

As of May 5, 1998, the 5th and H Streets Reconstruction Project (PN:TK74) had a balance of \$593,715. Additional funding appropriations, in the amount of \$154,000, will be made to the project as follows:

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:


The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 58.





5. The 1997/98 Capital Improvements Program is hereby further amended by transferring \$114,000 from the Gas Tax Contingency Reserve Fund (202-710-7012-4999) to the 5th and H Streets Reconstruction Project (202-500-TK74-4820).
