RESOLUTION TO INCREASE CASH BASIS FUND TO
\$200,000.00.


WHEREAS, the Cash Basis Fund created by Section 149 of the Charter of the City of Sacramento effective July 1, 1912, contained the sum only of \$49,310.28 when the present Charter became effective on June 30, 1921, and which, under Section 79 of said last named Charter, became the present Cash Basis Fund, and

WHEREAS, practical experience has shown that a permanent revolving fund of such amount only does not accomplish in a satisfactory manner the results for which it was designed, and

WHEREAS, it would not unduly deplete the General Fund to transfer at this time to said Cash Basis Fund an amount sufficient to increase it to \$200,000.00,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City Controller transfer from the General Fund to the Cash Basis Fund the sum of \$150,689.72.
