RESOLUTION ACCEPTING RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED

WHEREAS, LOUIS D. CARLSON, and ADA H. CARLSON, his wife, and JOHN SANDBURG, and MINNIE E. SANDBURG, his wife

have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Right-of-Way Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:

All that portion of the 319.91 acre tract of land described in the deed dated October 3, 1943, recorded December 2, 1943, in Book 1036 of Official Records of Sacramento County, Filing No. 25393, executed by Mary Anna Richardson, executrix of the last will and testament of William S. Kendall, deceased, to M. Sandburg and Louis B. Carlson, described as follows:

A strip of land of a uniform width of ten (10.00) feet lying equally on each side of the following described center line: Beginning at the northwesterly corner of Lot 202 of Orchard Terrace Unit No. 2, the official plat of which is recorded in Book 27 of Maps, Map No. 37; thence from said point of beginning North 56° 05' 40" West 72.21 feet; thence North 22° 19' West 598.46 feet; thence North 64° 35' 30" West 201.75 feet; thence North 31° 39' 30" East 182.30 feet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said Right-of-Way Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said Right-of-Way Deed, and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
