**APPROVING RELEASE AND REFERRAL OF THE PROPOSED
THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE
SACRAMENTO ARMY DEPOT REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT**


WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 *et seq.*), the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento (the "Agency") has prepared a proposed amendment (the "Third Amendment") to the Redevelopment Plan for the Sacramento Army Depot Redevelopment Project for the purpose of adding certain new territory to the Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the California Community Redevelopment Law, in particular Health and Safety Code Sections 33354.6 and 33346, provides that before a redevelopment plan amendment adding new territory is submitted to the legislative body for consideration, the redevelopment agency shall submit the proposed amendment to the planning commission for its report and recommendation, including a determination whether the proposed amendment is in conformity with the jurisdiction's general plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The proposed Third Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Sacramento Army Depot Redevelopment Project, which is provided as Attachment 3 to the staff report accompanying this resolution, is hereby approved for referral to the Planning Commission of the City of Sacramento for its report and recommendation. The Executive Director is authorized and directed to transmit the proposed Third Amendment to the Planning Commission of the City of Sacramento.

Section 2. The proposed Third Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Sacramento Army Depot Redevelopment Project is hereby approved for release to the Redevelopment Advisory Committee and the general public for review and comment.
