ORDINANCE NO. 1489 - , FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1446, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 13, 1949, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO IMPOSING A LICENSE TAX FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF SELLING TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY AT RETAIL, PROVIDING FOR PERMITS TO RETAILERS, PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTING AND PAYING OF SUCH TAX, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1446, Fourth Series, passed June 13, 1949, and entitled: "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO IMPOSING A LICENSE TAX FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF SELLING TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY AT RETAIL, PROVIDING FOR PERMITS TO RETAILERS, PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTING AND PAYING OF SUCH TAX, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF," is hereby repealed.


That the effect of this repeal shall not be considered to cancel or relieve the payment of any taxes, or payments already accrued and payable up to and including the effective date hereof. That any liabilities already accrued, payments due, or causes of action, shall continue in full force and effect until discharged.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be published once in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento and shall take effect 30 days from and after its passage.


