Title: Execution of the Transportation Development Act Claim Packet for Fiscal Year 2010/2011

Recommendation: Adopt a **Resolution:** 1) approving a Transportation Development Act claim for reimbursement in the amount of \$218,939 for various bicycle and pedestrian facilities in Fiscal Year 2010/2011 (FY2010/11); and 2) authorizing the City Manager to execute and submit the Transportation Development Act claim in the amount of \$218,939 for FY2010/11 to the Sacramento Area Council of Governments for approval and reimbursement to Transportation Development Act Funds, Fund 2013.

Description/Analysis

Issue: This is an annual process to “claim” Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds. Applications are completed and need to be submitted to the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) for reimbursement. For the current fiscal year, \$218,939 may be claimed for reimbursement. Staff recommends authorizing the City Manager to execute and submit the claim for the aforementioned dollar amount. The City has dedicated these funds to off-street bikeway development and implementation is coordinated with the Department of Transportation. The projects and funding have been approved in the 2010-2015 Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

Policy Considerations: Providing Parks and Recreation facilities is consistent with the City's strategic plan to achieve sustainability and liveability and to expand economic development throughout the City. This action is in compliance with the 2010 Sacramento City / County Bikeway Master Plan and SACOG's Metropolitan Transportation Plan.

Committee/Commission Action: Not applicable.

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): It has been determined that the action of executing the TDA claim for FY2010/11 and applying to SACOG for TDA funds for various bicycle and pedestrian facilities for FY2010/11 does not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt under CEQA Guidelines (Title 14 Cal. Code Reg. § 15000 et seq.) Categorical Exemption Section 15061 (b)(3), of CEQA. However, any subsequent actions for implementation of the TDA will be required to undergo CEQA review.

Sustainability Considerations: Not applicable.

Rationale for Recommendation: In order to receive the City's allocation, SACOG requires a claim package to be submitted. The claim package details new projects, provides the status of existing TDA projects, and highlights program changes.

Financial Considerations: City staff is ready to process the FY2010/11 TDA claim for \$218,939 (Fund 2013) relating to the costs of the improvements listed below. In order to receive an allocation, SACOG requires a claim package (Exhibit A, page 6) to be submitted. The claim package details new projects, provides the status of existing TDA projects, and highlights program changes. The breakdown for the reimbursements is listed in the following table:



The Transportation Development Act (TDA) of 1974 allows two percent (2%) of the Local Transportation Fund apportionment to be made available exclusively for pedestrian and bicycle facilities. The Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) is the transportation/planning agency for this area and, as such, is responsible for the allocation of Local Transportation Funds to jurisdictions in Sacramento County.

In the *Fiscal Year 2010-2015 Capital Improvement Program Budget* resolution (2010-388), City Council authorized funds for maintenance and repair of existing bikeways and development of new bikeways throughout the City of Sacramento. In order to receive the City's allocation, SACOG requires a claim package to be submitted. The claim package details new projects, provides the status of existing TDA projects, and highlights program changes.

**APPROVING EXECUTION OF THE TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT
CLAIM PACKET FOR FY2010/11**

BACKGROUND:

- A. The Transportation Development Act (TDA) of 1974 allows two percent of Local Transportation Fund apportionment to be made available exclusively for pedestrian and bicycle facilities.
- B. In the *2010-2015 Capital Improvement Program Budget* (Resolution 2010-388), City Council authorized funds for maintenance and repair of existing bikeways and development of new bikeways throughout the City of Sacramento.
- C. Sacramento Area Council of Governments requires a claim package be submitted in order to receive any allocation.

- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute and submit the TDA claim in the amount of \$218,939 for FY2010/11 to the Sacramento Area Council of Governments for approval and reimbursement to the TDA fund, Fund 2013.
- Section 3. The TDA Claim Packet for FY2010/11 attached as Exhibit A is made a part of this Resolution.
