

Sacramento, California,

August 28, 1931.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at six o'clock P. M. in the office of the Board, Room 106 City Hall, President Chenu presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Weisman and Chenu.
ABSENT : Commissioner Maloney.

The reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with.

A committee composed of Mr. Schaedler, Mr. Fuller, and Mr. Woods, representing the Civil Service Employees Association, appeared before the Board on behalf of A. A. Spencer, ^{and} Ernest A. Baker who are employed as Tree Trimmers in the City Park Department. The committee requested information relative to the present status of the above mentioned employees. After consideration, Commissioner Weisman moved that the question involved be taken under advisement. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu. The vote was as follows:

NOES: None. ABSENT: Commissioner Maloney.

The Board next proceeded with the Oral examination for Garbageman. Sixteen candidates appeared for examination.

A communication was received from Henry H. Brown, Adjutant of Holland Laidler Camp No. 5, U.S.W.V., requesting information relative to the reemployment of James H. Gerard, a former employee

Commissioner Maloney moved that the Secretary be instructed to advise Mr. Brown that Mr. Gerard was disqualified by the examining physician. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weisman. The vote was as follows:

Commissioner Maloney moved that the Secretary be instructed to advise the Engineering Department of the necessity of separating W. Quaresma, employed temporarily as Laborer, and employing an eligible from the Laborer's list in regular order.
