SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ON VARIOUS STREETS

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Altos Avenue between El Camino Avenue and Eleanor Avenue, District 2; Muir Way between Broadway and Vallejo Way, District 4; El Centro Road between the West Drainage Canal and the North City limits, District 1; El Centro Road between San Juan Road and the City limits, District 1.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution which:

- 1. Repeals Resolution No. 97-184
- 2. Establishes an appropriate speed limit on Altos Avenue between El Camino Avenue and Eleanor Avenue, Muir Way between Broadway and Vallejo Way, El Centro Road between the West Drainage Canal and the North City limits, and El Centro Road between San Juan Road and the City limits.

City Council Resolution Repealing Resolution 97-184 and Declaring Prima-Facie Speed Limits September 9, 1997

SUMMARY:

In response to neighborhood concerns regarding vehicular speeding on their streets and recently enacted State legislation, staff conducted engineering and traffic surveys on Altos Avenue, Muir Way and El Centro Road, which are included in this report as Attachments 1 through 6 respectively. Findings of the engineering and traffic surveys indicate that:

- The appropriate speed limit on Altos Avenue between El Camino Avenue and Eleanor Avenue is 25 miles per hour (mph), which is a 5 mph reduction from the currently posted 30 mph.
- The appropriate speed limit on Muir Way between Broadway and Vallejo Way is 25 mph, which is a 5 mph reduction from the currently posted 30 mph.
- The appropriate speed limit on El Centro Road between the West Drainage Canal and the North City limits is 50 mph.
- The appropriate speed limit on El Centro Road between San Juan Road and the City limits is 50 mph.

A summary of the attached speed studies performed for the above locations is included in Exhibit A.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On April 5, 1973, the Sacramento City Council adopted Sacramento City Ordinance No. 3259-Fourth Series. The ordinance established realistic speed limits, using engineering and traffic surveys, on 212 segments of roadway within the City, which had previously established speed limits. An amendment to the California Vehicle Code that became law on March 7, 1973 made evidence of speed obtained by radar inadmissible unless the speed limit is justified by an engineering survey within the past five years. That is, using radar to enforce an unrealistic or outdated speed limit constitutes a speed trap and would no longer be allowed.

City Council Resolution Repealing Resolution 97-184 and Declaring Prima-Facie Speed Limits September 9, 1997

On December 8, 1995, Federal Legislation eliminated the national maximum speed limit of 55 mph. California State Senate Bill 726 was signed into law by Governor Wilson and became effective on January 2, 1996, which provides local authorities with additional discretion in the determination of prima facie speed limits. Beginning March 31, 1996, the City may declare prima facie speed limits up to 60 mph or maximum speed limits or 65 mph, if it so desires. Such increases, however, would first require engineering and traffic surveys. In addition, beginning March 31, 1996, local roads, which presently have maximum speed limits of 55 mph, will automatically be raised to 65 mph unless the "local authority" determines otherwise based upon an engineering and traffic survey.

On March 29, 1996, Governor Wilson signed into law California State Senate Bill 848, which took effect immediately as "urgent" legislation, allows local roads that currently have maximum speed limits of 55 mph to remain at 55 mph, unless the local authority determines, upon the basis of a traffic and engineering survey, that the maximum speed limit should be raised to 60 mph or 65 mph.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

No additional City funds are requested.

The costs associated for staff to perform the speed surveys, manufacturing and installation of speed limit signs are included in the operating budget for the Department of Public Works.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Pursuant to Section 15378 (b) (3), this is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This report is submitted in accordance with current City policy and the Current California Vehicle Code, Sections; 32, 22352, and 22358 regarding "Action Local Authorities May Take by Resolution", "Prima Facie Speed Limits", and "Decrease of Local Limits", respectively.

Exhibit A

SPEED STUDY SUMMARIES

Altos Avenue

The Traffic Services staff conducted three engineering surveys for speed limits on Altos Avenue between El Camino Avenue and Eleanor Avenue. The engineering survey conducted between El Camino Avenue and Leitch Avenue (Attachment 1) demonstrated that the 85th percentile and average speeds are 32 and 28 miles per hour (mph) respectively. The survey conducted between Leitch Avenue and Fairfield (Attachment 2) showed the 85th percentile and average speed to be 34 and 30 mph respectively. The final survey conducted between Eleanor Avenue and Lampasas Avenue (Attachment 3) demonstrated that the 85th percentile and the average speed are 34 and 31 mph respectively. The 85th percentile speeds from the three surveys would typically indicate that the posted speed limit should be 30 mph, which is the current posted speed limit. However, several factors were taken into consideration. Firstly, the segment of Altos Avenue between El Camino Avenue and Eleanor Avenue is immediately adjacent to The Sacramento Northern Bikeway. Secondly, Altos Avenue has residential units along its entirety. Because of the residential frontage units, the large numbers of pedestrians and cyclists, staff recommends that the speed limit on Altos Avenue from El Camino Avenue to Eleanor Avenue be lowered from 30 mph to 25 mph.

Muir Way

The Traffic Services staff conducted an engineering survey for speed limits on Muir Way between Broadway and Vallejo Way (Attachment 4). The engineering survey demonstrated that the 85th percentile and average speeds are 33 and 26 mph respectively. The 85th percentile speed indicates that the appropriate posted speed limit for this segment of Muir Way is 30 mph. However, other factors were given consideration; Due to the residential frontage units and a large elementary school population within the neighborhood boundary and along Muir Way, staff recommends that the speed limit on Muir Way between Broadway and Vallejo Way be lowered from 30 mph to 25 mph.

El Centro Road

The Traffic Services staff conducted an engineering survey for the speed limits on El Centro Road between the West Drainage Canal and the North City limits. The engineering survey conducted between Del Paso Road and the North City limits (Attachment 5) demonstrated that the 85th percentile and average speeds are 55

mph and 53 mph, respectively. The 85th percentile speed indicates that the appropriate posted speed for this segment is 55 mph. However, other factors were given consideration; Due to the street lighting conditions, no shoulders and drainage canals on either side of El Centro Road, staff recommends a posted speed limit on El Centro Road between the West Drainage Canal and the North City limits of 50 mph.

El Centro Road

The Traffic Services staff conducted an engineering survey for the speed limits on El Centro Road between San Juan Road and the City limits. The engineering survey conducted between San Juan Road and the City limits (Attachment 6) demonstrated that the 85th percentile and average speeds are 55 mph and 52 mph, respectively. The 85th percentile speed indicates that the appropriate posted speed for this segment is 55 mph. However, other factors were given consideration; Due to the street lighting conditions, no shoulders and drainage canals on either side of El Centro Road, staff recommends a posted speed limit on El Centro Road between San Juan Road and the City limits of 50 mph.
