COOPERATIVE PURCHASE AGREEMENT: SEWER/STORM DRAIN CLEANING TRUCKS

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Public Works (DPW), Fleet Management Division, has a customer requirement to purchase two replacement, and one additional, sewer/storm drain cleaning trucks for the Department of Utilities (DOU), Operations and Maintenance Division. The additional truck is required to maintain drains and pipes and will support DOU's Drainage System Management Plan.
- B. The recommended purchases will be made from the DPW FY2014/15 operating budget (Fleet Fund, Fund 6501), however an adjustment to the DPW operating budget is necessary because one of the sewer/storm drain cleaning trucks is an addition to the fleet and is not yet budgeted in the Fleet Fund. Upon completion of the recommended budget adjustment, sufficient funds will be available in the FY2014/15 DPW operating budget to make purchase.
- C. In accordance with City Code Section 3.56.240, the City Manager, where advantageous to the City, may, by cooperative purchase agreements approved by the City Council, purchase supplies or nonprofessional services through legal contracts of other governmental jurisdictions or public agencies without separate competitive bidding by the City.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to increase the expenditure and revenue budgets in the DPW FY2014/15 operating budget (Fleet Fund, Fund 6501) in the amount of \$496,190.
- Section 2. Using the cooperative purchase agreement with the Houston Galveston Area Council (HGAC) cooperative purchase agreement with Vac-Con, Inc. (Contract No.SC01-15) for the purchase of two replacement, and one additional, sewer/storm drain cleaning trucks in an amount not to exceed \$1,399,772 is approved.

Section 3. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the purchases specified above.
