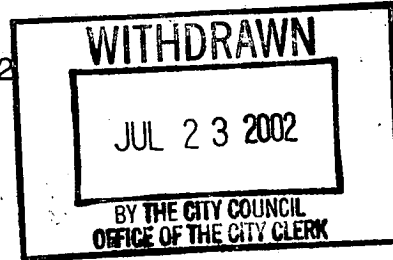

**SUBJECT: HIGHWAY 50/HOWE AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (PN:TU01) –
APPROVAL OF THE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE
DEPARTMENT OF CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Howe Avenue and Highway 50. Council District 6. (See Map, Attachment A).

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the attached Traffic Enforcement Agreement between the City of Sacramento and the Department of California Highway Patrol for the Highway 50/Howe Avenue Improvement Project.

SUMMARY:

Approval of the Traffic Enforcement Agreement between the City of Sacramento and the Department of California Highway Patrol is required to provide lane closures during construction of the Highway 50/Howe Avenue Interchange Project.

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California Highway Patrol Officers will be stationed on-site during lane closures to provide enforcement and high visibility of the lane closure and construction zone.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The project will increase the number of through lanes on Howe Avenue from four to six lanes between College Town Drive and Folsom Boulevard and construct interchange ramp widening and metering. The existing sound wall at the northeast quadrant of the interchange will also be replaced with a taller sound wall. The project will also add a new left turn pocket onto the Highway 50 westbound on-ramp from Hornet Drive. These improvements will relieve traffic congestion in this area and alleviate noise impacts.

During construction, the California Highway Patrol will provide on-site traffic enforcement. This report requests that the City Council approve the Traffic Enforcement Agreement between the City of Sacramento and the Department of California Highway Patrol for the Highway 50/Howe Avenue Improvement Project (PN:TU01).

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost of this Agreement is for a not to exceed amount of \$150,000. The current total budget is \$7,136,000. As of July 1, 2002, the unobligated balance is \$6,090,724.26, which is sufficient to award the agreement in the amount not to exceed \$150,000.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The current request is for Council to approve the Traffic Enforcement Agreement between the City of Sacramento and the Department of California Highway Patrol for improvements to the Highway 50/Howe Avenue Interchange. The action to be undertaken by the Department of California Highway Patrol is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to Section 15301.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:



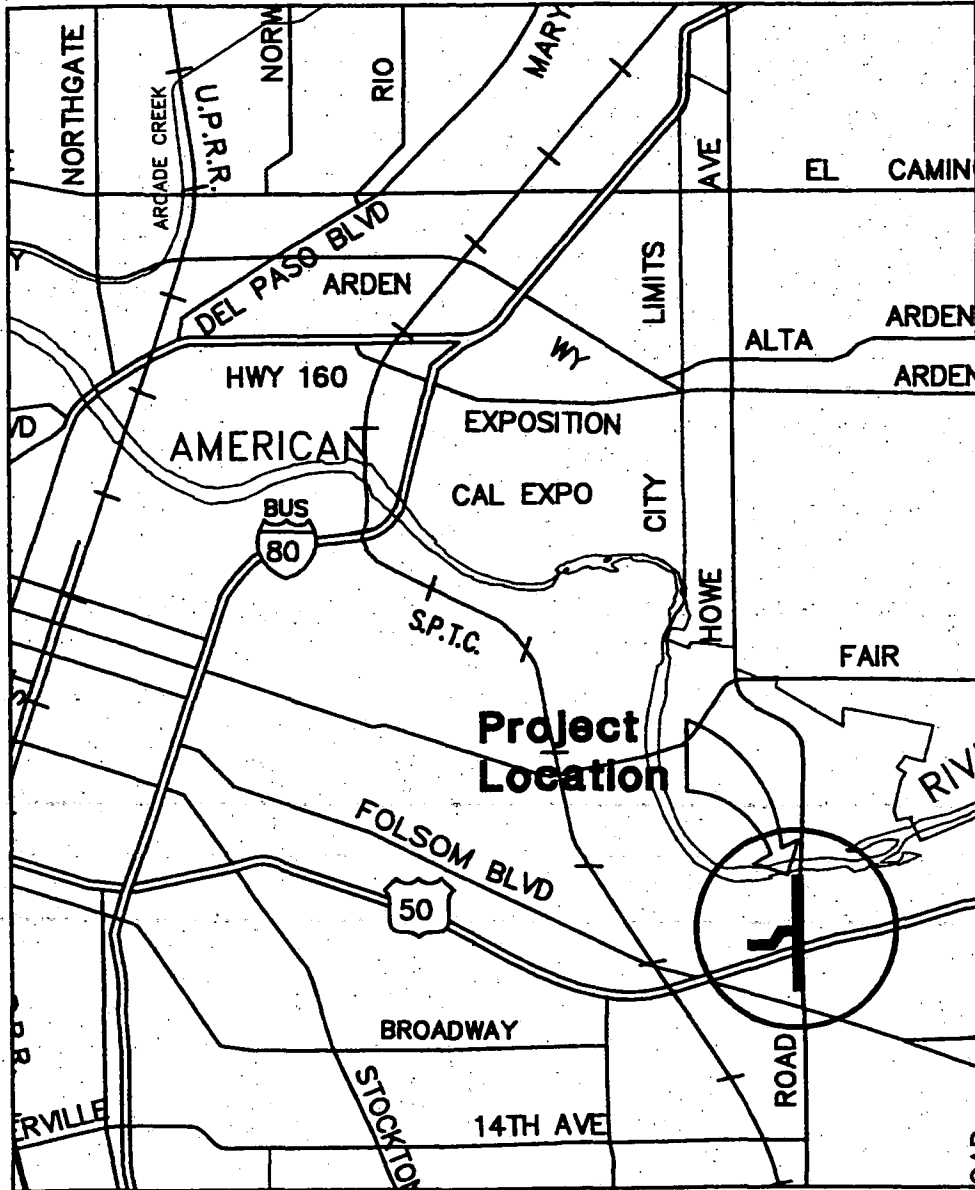

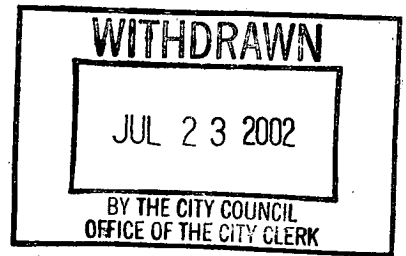
