SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for Slurry Sealing
of Various City Streets

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for the slurry sealing of various City Streets have been prepared. It is recommended that staff be directed to forward the plans and specifications to Council for approval and advertisement for bids.

BACKGROUND:

The project is a continuation of the on-going program to protect the City streets from deterioration. The project is funded under the operating budget and is included in the Preliminary Budget for FY 1981-82. Approval of plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is being requested before Budget approval to ensure completion of the project before the rainy season; however, the contract will not be awarded until after the Budget is approved.

FINANCIAL:


The engineer's cost estimate for the project is \$140,556 and is contained in the operating budget for the Street Maintenance Division for FY 1981-82.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend to the full City Council that plans and specifications be approved for the subject project and the project be advertised for bids.
