

RESOLUTION NO. 313

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
March 21, 1947.

WHEREAS, the State Park Commission recently held a meeting in the City of Sacramento on February 21, 1947; for the purposes of ordering a survey to be made of possible sites to be included in the State Park System for park areas within the valley, mountain and desert regions of the State; and

WHEREAS, at this meeting there appeared MR. GLENN HALL, City Planning Engineer of the City of Sacramento, and MR. CHARLES W. DETERDING, County Executive of the County of Sacramento, and requested that all areas adjoining the Sacramento and American Rivers, within the Counties of Sacramento and Yolo and within the metropolitan area of Sacramento, be included in this survey which is to be made; and

WHEREAS, the State Park Commission has ordered that this survey be made by Mr. Frederick Law Olmsted, Consultant for the Commission, and both Mr. Deterding and Mr. Hall have agreed to render such assistance as may be necessary to Mr. Olmsted, the Commission's Consultant; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Sacramento is vitally interested in seeing that suitable portions of these areas are developed so that their natural beauty and splendor may be exhibited and enjoyed for public park and recreational purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That it is the sense of the Council of the City of Sacramento that it join in the action taken by the City Planning Engineer and the County Executive in requesting that both sides of the Sacramento River in Sacramento and Yolo Counties, and of the American River in Sacramento County, within the metropolitan area of this city, be included in the survey to be made by the Consultant for the State Park Commission; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Planning Engineer is further authorized to offer facilities of his office in the making of such maps, diagrams and the preparation of such technical data as may be required to offer assistance to the Consultant for the State Park Commission, Mr. Frederick Law Olmsted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the State Park Commission.
