RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ORDER MAINTENANCE OF IMPROVEMENTS FOR NEIGHBORHOOD LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 96-07 FOR FY 1999/00 (Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972)

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO RESOLVES:

- 1. The City Council intends to levy and collect assessments within the Neighborhood Lighting District No. 96-07 during fiscal year 1999/00. The area of land to be assessed is located in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County.
- 2. The maintenance of improvements to be made in this assessment district are generally described as follows:
 - The improvements consist of operation and maintenance of neighborhood street lights on wood poles receiving electrical power by overhead electrical lines, and the engineering, administrative and miscellaneous costs related to the district.
- 3. In accordance with this Council's resolution directing the filing of an annual report, the Engineer of Work has filed with the City Clerk the report required by the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972. All interested persons are referred to that report for a full and detailed description of the improvements, the boundaries of the assessment district, and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the assessment district.
- At the hour of 2:00 p.m., on Tuesday, June 29, 1999, the City Council will conduct a 4. public hearing on the questions of the levy of the proposed annual assessment. The hearing will be held at the meeting place of the City Council located in City Hall, 915 I Street, 2nd Floor, Sacramento, California.
