**RECOMMENDATION:**

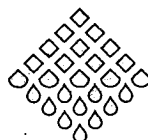

**SUMMARY:**

This portion of the CSUS Outfall Project has been included in the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) South Bank Slurry Wall Project through the City's local sponsor, SAFCA. Bids have been received by USACE and the total construction costs for this project are estimated at \$129,200.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

In 1996, Black & Veatch completed the Drainage Master Plan for Sumps 31, 38, 113 and 155. In keeping with the recommendations of that Master Plan, the City has initiated a project to increase the capacity of the Sump 31 Pump Station and run the outfall across the CSUS campus (it presently outfalls into the CSUS drainage ditch). There are two US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) projects that will be constructed in the vicinity of the outfall. One is the Site 4 Bank Protection Project, which was completed in the summer of 1999; and the other is the South Levee Slurry Wall Project, scheduled for construction in the summer of 2000. The installation of the portion of the Sump 31 outfall line which goes through the south levee has been incorporated into the USACE South Levee Slurry Wall Project. This was done in an effort to protect the integrity of both the outfall lines and the slurry wall by having them both constructed by the same contractor. The proposed cost given by the USACE contractor is reasonable and within the range of our cost estimates.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

There are sufficient funds in the Storm Drainage Fund Capital Improvement Program (PN:WI11) to fund the construction contract.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, the Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the proposed project. This review has resulted in the determination that the proposed project will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and a Negative Declaration was prepared. On June 22, 1999, Council ratified the Negative Declaration for this project.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code 3.60.170 regarding the suspension of competitive bidding.



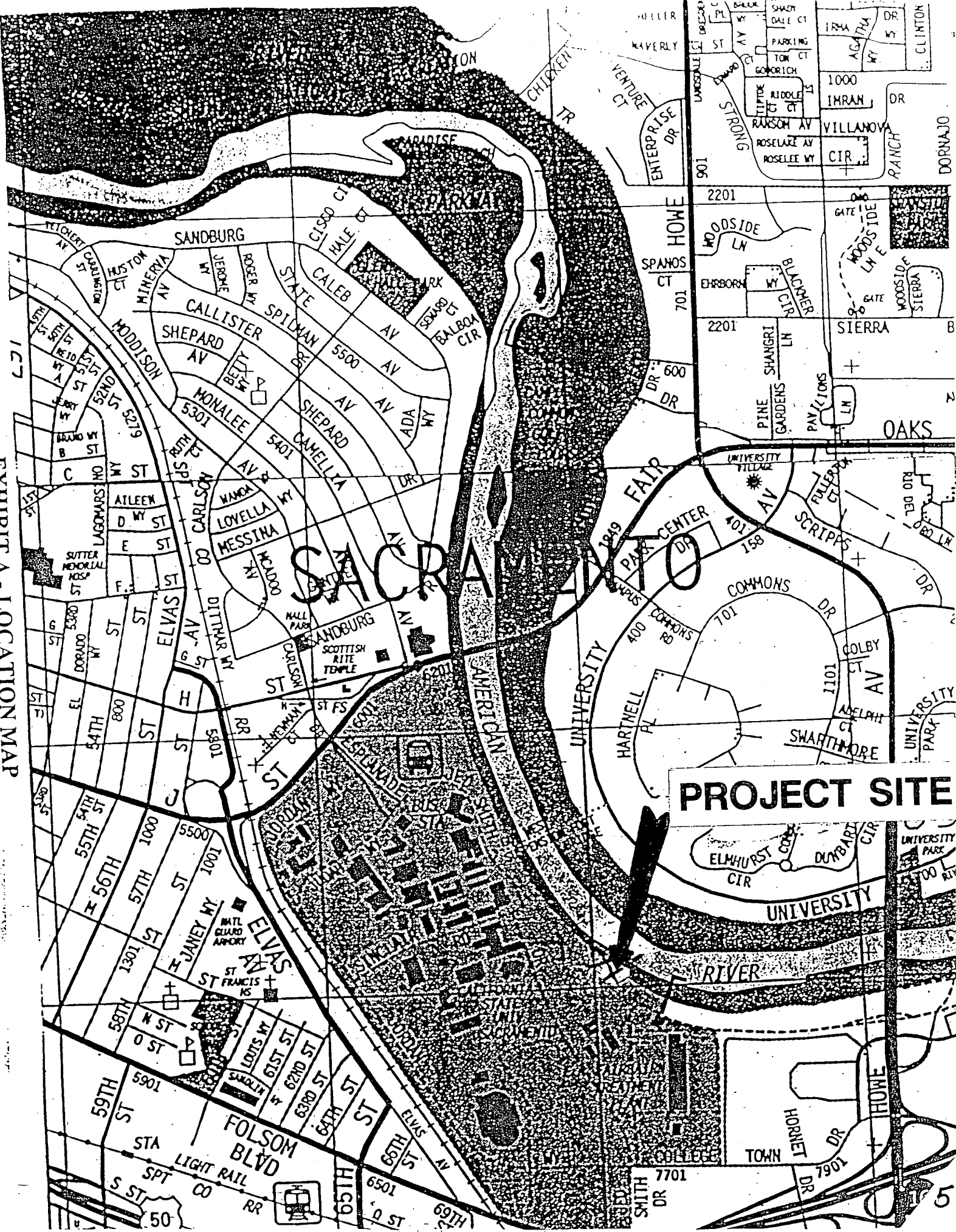
