

ORDINANCE NO. 1628, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE MAXIMUM HOURS OF WORK EACH WEEK FOR UNIFORM MEMBERS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, TO TAKE EFFECT JULY 1, 1952,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Uniform members of the Police Department shall not be required to work in excess of 5 days each week or in excess of 40 hours each week, except in case of emergency.

SECTION 2: Holidays and vacation periods regularly granted to city employees shall be included as days worked in computing the maximum hours of work for uniform members of the Police Department herein over each year period.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the City of Sacramento in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1952.

SECTION 5: If any clause, sentence, section, provision, or part of this ordinance is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not impair, affect, or invalidate the remainder of this act which shall remain in full force and effect thereafter.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall be published once in the Official Newspaper of the City of Sacramento within 10 days after its approval.

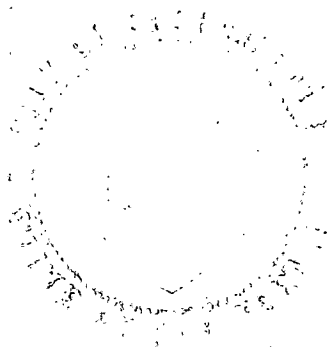
