

RESOLUTION No. 286

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
December 14, 1943

RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby expresses to the members of the City Planning Commission and its aides its sincere appreciation and highest compliments in the preparation and submission of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance to the City Council of the City of Sacramento; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this body in adopting said measure feel confident it will represent the most forward and beneficial features known in the field of zoning, guaranteeing to this City zoning regulations which will accomplish a continued stabilization, protection and improvement of both public and private property in this City and its environs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the present budget for the year ending June 30, 1944 be increased the sum of \$2,000 for the purpose of hiring the necessary clerical or other help in connection with work on the City Plan, to be appropriated from any moneys available for such purposes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a full time planning engineer or executive in charge of City Planning be hired, and that this action of the Council be expressed to the City Manager.
