

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2616

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, that the public interest and convenience require that the work hereinafter described should be done:

NOW THEREFORE, the said City Council does hereby resolve and declare that it is the intention of said City Council to order the following street work to be done to-wit:

To close, vacate, and abandon a portion of the Alley in the block bounded by North B and A Streets, 18th and 19th Streets, lying between lines drawn parallel to and distant 115 feet and 185 feet respectively easterly from the center line of 18th Street, reserving however, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct, sewer, water, and gas pipes, and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities, now in place in said Street and Alley or which from time to time may be placed therein. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid closing are to be taken subject to such reservations and exceptions.

And said City Council does hereby determine and declare that said proposed work and improvement is of more than local or ordinary public benefit and will affect and benefit the lands and district hereinafter described, and which said district is hereby declared to be the district affected, and benefited by said work and improvement and that therefore the entire damages, costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be and are hereby made chargeable against and shall be assessable upon said lands and district, which district is within the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California.

The exterior boundaries of the land affected and benefited by said work and improvement are particularly described as follows:

On the North by North B Street,
On the South by A Street,
On the West by 18th Street,
and on the East by 19th Street.,

And the said City Council does hereby elect to proceed to do said work under the provisions of Division 9, Part 3, "Streets and Highways Code", the " Street Vacation Act of 1931", being an Act of Legislature of the State of California, approved May 13th, 1941.

Notice is hereby given that all persons interested in or object-
ing to the proposed vacation, may appear before the said City Council,
in the Council Chamber, located on "I" Street between 9th and 10th
Streets in said City on March 7th, 1947 at 8:00 P. M. and be heard
in the matter.

The Sacramento Union is hereby designated as the daily news-
paper published and circulated in said City, in which this Reso-
lution shall be published, and the Superintendent of Streets is
hereby directed to post notices of the passage of this Resolution
in the manner as required by law,
