SUBJECT: <sup>D</sup> Authorizing Expenditure of Funds - Camellia School Park  
Site, 7332 Elder Creek Road

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

As part of the neighborhood and school park program, additional open space is needed adjacent to Camellia School on Elder Creek Road. Plans for the subject two-acre park site include tennis courts and a portion to be used as a softball field. The property presently contains a three bedroom dwelling and accessory buildings.

FINANCIAL DATA

This estimated cost of this acquisition to the City is \$85,000.00 and has been allocated by the Department of Community Services in their 1979-80 budget.

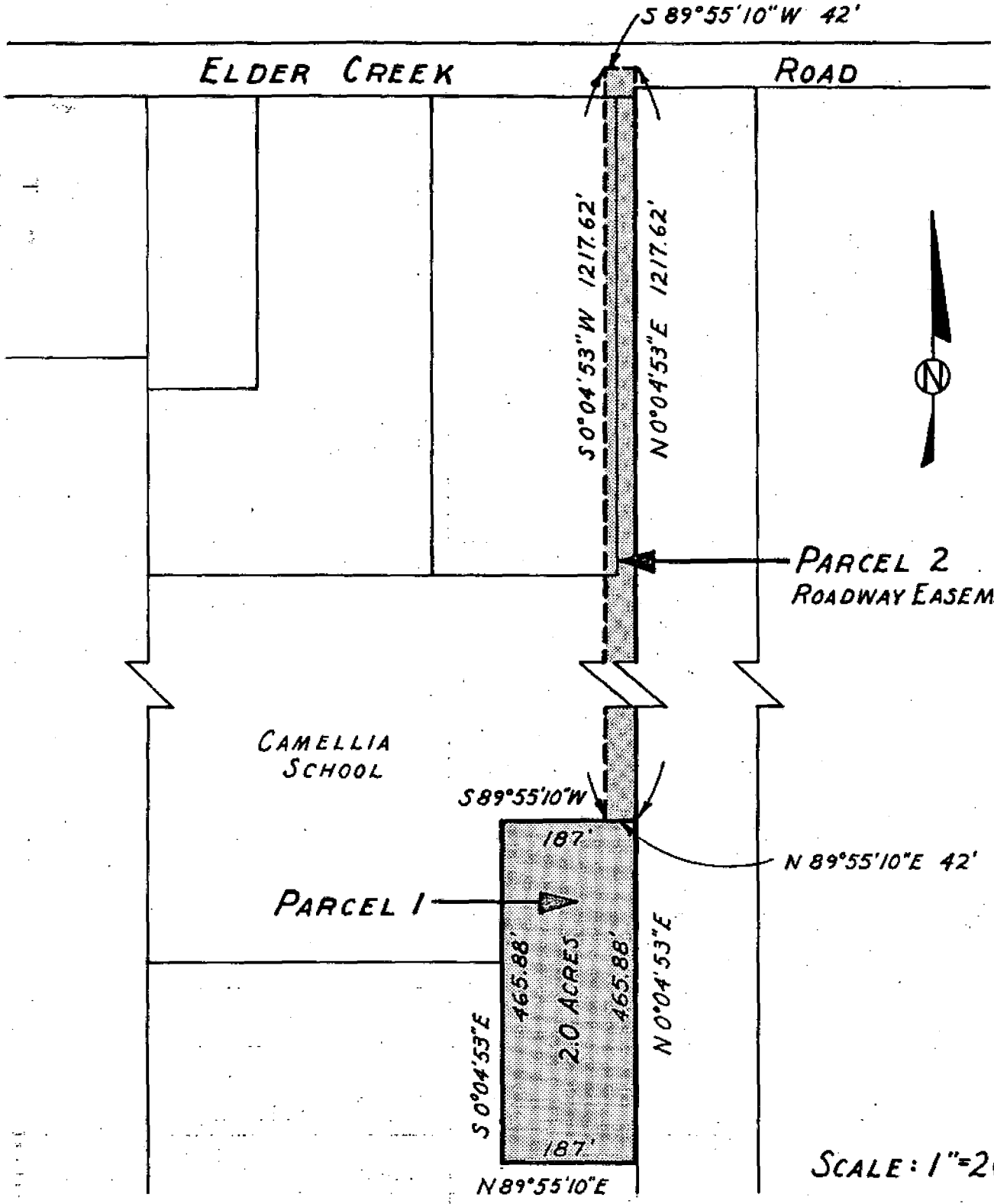
