STREET IN THE SUTTER HOSPITAL RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA.

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

47th Street from H to F Streets. Council District 3

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution modifying parking regulations on 47<sup>th</sup> Street between H and F Streets from two-hour parking Monday through Friday except with "A" permit to one-hour parking Monday through Saturday except with "A" permit.

## **SUMMARY:**

This report recommends modifying the parking regulations on a portion of 47<sup>th</sup> Street. Modifying the parking regulations from two-hour parking Monday through Friday except with "A" permit to one-hour parking Monday through Saturday except with "A" permit will relieve the parking congestion and provide residents with parking near their homes while maintaining short term parking from area businesses.

#### **COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- Two nearby businesses have generated additional parking congestion in the residential neighborhood making it difficult for resident to park near their homes.
- Residents submitted a petition requesting that parking be limited to residents only.
- While resident only parking would provide additional parking for residents it
  would create a hardship for the nearby businesses by reducing the amount
  of short-term customer parking.
- A comprise solution was to reduce the parking time limit to one-hour. This
  would protect the residential neighborhood from long-term parking and
  provide the businesses with short-term customer parking.
- There is adequate employee parking adjacent to the businesses.

## FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking modification is \$200 for the modification of the existing signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking & Animal care services operating budget.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has review the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under section 15301 (c) of the CEQA guidelines.



A RESOLUTION MODIFYING PARKING REGULATIONS ON A PORTION OF 47 <sup>th</sup> STREET IN THE SUTTER HOSPITAL RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.48.190 of the Sacramento City Code, on-street parking regulations within a residential permit parking area may be changed by resolution of the City Council based on recommendation by the Parking Manager.
THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:
The on-street parking regulations in the Sutter Hospital residential permit parking shall be modified as follows:
Modify the two-hour parking time limit Monday through Eriday except with "A" permit to one-hour parking Monday through Saturday except with "A" permit on the following street segment:
• 47 <sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, from 100 feet north of H Street and F Street.
