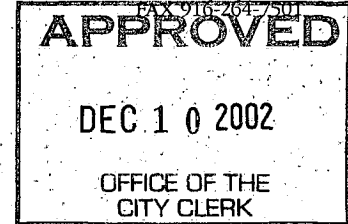

SUBJECT: RESOLUTIONS PROHIBITING PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS AND ESTABLISHING A PARKING TIME ZONE ON A PORTION OF VALLEJO WAY

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Vallejo Way, from Land Park Drive to 17th Street. Council District 4.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the attached resolutions be adopted to prohibit parking from 7:30 am to 8:30 am and 1:30 pm to 2:30 pm and to establish a one-hour time zone from 8:30 am to 1:30 pm on the south side of Vallejo Way from Land Park Drive to 17th Street.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends that all parking on a portion of Vallejo Way be prohibited during the time students are coming to and leaving from school (Exhibit A.) It also recommends that a one-hour time zone be established during school hours. Prohibiting all parking during the morning and afternoon hours will relieve the parking congestion during peak times. The one-hour time zone during school hours will provide visitors a convenient place to park and reduce the number of vehicles parked along the street.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Area residents have been complaining about the traffic and parking conditions in front of California Middle School on Vallejo Way.
- Vehicles dropping off and picking up students create traffic and parking congestion problems for area residents.
- Prohibiting all parking during peak times will relieve traffic congestion when students arrive and leave school.
- Parking time limits during school hours will deter all-day parking and reduce the number of vehicles parked on the street.
- School officials and area residents are supportive of this solution.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulations is estimated to be \$1,000 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This recommendation is consistent with the City's Strategic Plan and the goal of the City Council to enhance and preserve the neighborhoods.

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON A PORTION OF VALLEJO WAY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.36.040 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs are in place giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park on the days indicated on such signs, between the hours specified on such signs on any of the streets described in resolutions duly adopted by the City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

All parking shall be prohibited from 7:30 am to 8:30 am and 1:30 pm to 2:30 pm on the following street:

- Vallejo Way, south side, from Land Park Drive to 17th Street.

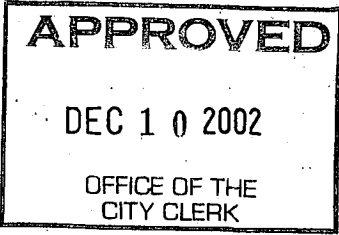

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A PARKING TIME ZONE
ON A PORTION OF VALLEJO WAY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.36.100 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs have been placed by the parking manager giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in a business district or on streets designated by resolutions during the days and hours indicated on such signs for a period of time longer than specified on such signs.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

All parking shall be limited to one-hour from 8:30 am to 1:30 pm on the following street:

- Vallejo Way, south side, from Land Park Drive to 17th Street.
