

ORDINANCE NO. 2026, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING SEVENTH AVENUE FROM THE EASTERLY LINE OF SAN CARLOS WAY TO THE WESTERLY LINE OF LOT A, AS SHOWN ON THE PLAT OF PLEASANT VIEW, AS THE SAME IS RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF SACRAMENTO COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Seventh Avenue from the Easterly line of San Carlos Way to the Westerly line of Lot A, as shown on the Plat of Pleasant View, as the same is recorded in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.

RESERVING, however, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water and gas pipes and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities, now in place in said Street or which from time to time may be placed therein.

Said closing and vacating is declared after due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by the City Council, which is hereby made, that said Street herein described is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within 10 days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
