AMENDMENT OF AREA 4 AGENCY ON AGING CONTRACT FOR RIVER CITY INFORMATION CENTER

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The Executive Director is authorized to execute an amendment to the agreement, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, between the Area 4 Agency on Aging and the Housing Authorities of the City and County of Sacramento to provide for additional funds of \$46,900 for the River City Information Center.

Section 2. (a) The Agency Community Services Division budget for 1984 has been amended to include the appropriation for the River City Information Center Program (Organization 400), which is \$46,900. The 1984 Agency budget is as follows:

2. This document is a binding Agreement to conduct a service project for senior citizens in a manner consistent with the intent and regulations applicable to service programs under Title III of the Older Americans Act of 1965 as amended 1981.
3. It is mutually agreed by the parties hereto that Agreement No. 84-303-1 is amended as follows:

\$46,900 of Older Americans Act Title III-B funding is added to the information and referral program on a one-time-only basis. Of the \$46,900, \$27,500 is to be used to offset the loss of funds from other sources for the I&R program, and \$19,400 is to be used to add a comprehensive assessment component to the program in conjunction with the Sacramento County Elderly Assessment Program. A Scope of Service for comprehensive assessment is attached. There is no revision to the Scope of Service for information and referral.
4. This amendment is effective January 1, 1984.
