**SUBJECT: SOFTWARE CONTRACT AWARD FOR ADVANCING COMMUNITY POLICING GRANT**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT: CITY-WIDE**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a resolution awarding a contract for \$193,574 to Analysis Central Systems(ACS) for deployment and problem identification software. This software is required and funded by a federal grant.

**SUMMARY:**

On July 28, 1998, the City Council accepted a \$250,000 grant from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services. The one year grant is funding the Community Policing Coordination and Deployment Project which is providing changes in the department's organizational structure, additional COPPS training for officers and citizens, and mutual problem solving through the use of new deployment and problem identification software.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Police Department is currently using a 1990 DOS version of ACS' deployment software. It advises the optimum distribution of officers, by time and location. The old version has served us well but has a number of limitations. The new version is Windows NT based. It is not only more user-friendly and more versatile, it is now coupled with a powerful problem identification program which will expedite the identification of and response to neighborhood problems.

In late 1995, department representatives witnessed a demonstration of the new version and were very impressed with its capabilities but did not have sufficient funding for the purchase at that time. A search revealed that no other vendors could meet the department's requirements.

In 1996, the Police Department sought a federal grant, under the Advancing Community Policing Program to fund the purchase of the ACS software as an integral component in the police department's expansion of community policing opportunities. The grant proposal indicated that ACS would be our software vendor based on the original research.

After receipt of the grant, and prior to beginning the contract process with ACS, another vendor search was conducted. In the end, however, our initial conclusions were confirmed. No other vendor can replicate ACS' mathematical model, scientific credentials, comprehensive approach, problem identification component, maintenance and support, and experience.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

This activity does not constitute a "project" and is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act(CEQA), CEQA Guidelines Sections 15061 and 15378.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Police Department has received a federal grant to cover the \$161,324 purchase price(tax inclusive). The contract requires two years of "maintenance and support" at a cost of \$16,100 per year, to be paid from Police Department funds, beginning with FY2001.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

The purchase of this software will assist the Police Department in achieving its community policing goals. The deployment program will increase efficiency while the problem identification program will increase the effectiveness of the department.

The vendor is City-certified as an ESBE.
