

SACRAMENTO CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

RESOLUTION NO. _____

WHEREAS: The State of California is presently engaged in the development of the new California Exposition facility, and

WHEREAS: The State of California proposes to make available for private development some 262 acres of surplus property north of and adjacent to said California Exposition, and

WHEREAS: The State of California at an appropriate time will also make available for public or private development, or a combination thereof, the existing California State Fair grounds comprising some 207 acres, and

WHEREAS: To date, no comprehensive plan has been prepared as a guide either to the development of the surplus lands of the California Exposition complex or reuse of the old California State Fair Site, and

WHEREAS: It is believed important that the development of such comprehensive plans be initiated at the earliest possible date.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: the Planning Commission of the City of Sacramento respectfully urges the State of California to cause such comprehensive plans be prepared in order that these two properties as they develop, may result in a coordinated project which will make significant contribution to the programs of the State of California, the City of Sacramento and the immediate area in which they are located.
