**REVOKING PERMIT TO FENCE UNUSED LEVEE RIGHT-OF-WAY**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. On November 12, 1964, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 411, granting to Richard Mayberry, at 7545 Titian Parkway, a revocable permit to fence unused levee right-of-way adjacent to Lot 85 of the Southgate Meadows #2 subdivision.
- B. Access to and use of this right-of-way area is now required for the Florin Creek Widening Project, necessitating revocation of the revocable permit previously issued by the City Council.
- C. Permits for the use of public property are revocable at the will of the City Council.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The revocable permit granted to Richard Mayberry by City Council Resolution No. 411 is revoked.
