**SUBJECT:** ELEANOR AVENUE STREET RECONSTRUCTION AND DRAINAGE  
IMPROVEMENTS (PN:TJ41/WB61) - PROJECT APPROVAL AND BID  
ADVERTISEMENT

**LOCATION/COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Eleanor Avenue between Johnston Park and Altos Avenue. Grove Avenue between Eleanor Avenue and Las Palmas Avenue located in District No. 2.

**SUMMARY**

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on June 3, 1992.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

This project involves the removal, replacement, or reconstruction of deteriorated storm drainage facilities, street sections, and curb, gutter and sidewalk. Collector pipe, maintenance holes, drop inlets and drain leads will be replaced in Eleanor Avenue between Johnston Park and Oakmont Street. Also included in

this project is the removal and reconstruction of street sections and deteriorated portions of curb, gutter, and sidewalk on Eleanor Avenue between Johnston Park and Altos Avenue, Grove Avenue between Eleanor and Las Palmas Avenues, and Las Palmas Avenue between Grove Avenue and Johnston Park.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on October 16, 1990 (PN:TJ41) and January 9, 1990 (PN:WB61). The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$1,201,300.

### FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Sufficient funds are available to complete this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$1,547,700. The current budget is \$1,556,570, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the following funds:



Contractors bidding on this project must possess a Class A and C-27 License.

All contractors, subcontractors and all concerned must comply with the rates of wages established by the Director of Industrial Relations under provisions of Sections 1770 and 1773 of the Labor Code of the State of California, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk; or such other rate of wages as may hereafter be established by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations in compliance with Section 1770 of the Labor Code of the State of California.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 4590, any contract awarded pursuant to this invitation for bid shall contain a provision permitting the substitution of securities for any moneys withheld to ensure performance under the contract. The terms of such provisions shall be according to the requirements of Government Code Section 4590.

The right to reject any and all bids or to waive any informality in any bid received is reserved by the City Council.
