**SUBJECT: 4TH AVE/VALLEJO WAY SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT, (PN: XM09) -
CONTRACT AWARD TO GELCO SERVICES, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$96,090**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

The project is located in the backyard easements between 4th Avenue and Vallejo Way (District 4).

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council accept the low bid of Insituform Technologies, dba Gelco Services, Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$96,090 and award the contract.

SUMMARY:

On May 21, 1996, the City Council approved Resolution No. 96-224 for the creation of a new Capital Improvement Project (XM09) and authorized for bids to be received on June 26, 1996, for the Sewer Main 4th Avenue and Vallejo Way Sewer Project. Only one bid was received and opened by the City Clerk on June 26, 1996. Gelco Services, Inc. is the low bidder at \$96,090.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This heavily deteriorated sewer line runs through backyards, under fences, and across heavily landscaped pockets with large trees. The dropped joints have permitted root intrusion and probable seepage; maintenance has become very difficult. This project will restore the structural integrity of the main to that of the original and will eliminate open trenching through the backyard easements; however, some spot repair conditions may exist that will require digging.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Planning Services Division, Environmental Section has reviewed the proposed project. This review has resulted in the determination that the proposed project is exempt as defined in Section number 1530(b) of the CEQA Guidelines.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The engineer's cost estimate for the project is \$112,600. Sufficient funding for this project is available in the Sewer Fund Capital Improvement Program (414/425-500-XM09) which has an unobligated balance of \$200,000 as of July 10, 1996.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.301 of the City Code for public projects and Resolution no. 93-619 relating to MBE/WBE participation goals and policies adopted by the City Council on November 2, 1995.




