Conducted a public hearing and upon conclusion a motion **passed** adopting 1) **City Resolution No. 2010-555** a) indicating that, pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Service Code (IRS Code), the City Council has, following notice duly given, held a public hearing regarding the deemed reissuance for federal tax purposes of a portion of the Sacramento City Financing Authority (Authority) 2005 Tax Allocation Revenue Bonds, Series A (Merged Downtown and Oak Park Projects) in an amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 allocable to the Hotel Berry project (Allocable Bonds), and has approved the deemed reissuance for federal tax purposes of the Allocable Bonds by the Authority; and b) indicating that the City Council has conducted a Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act (TEFRA) public hearing for the proposed construction and permanent financing of the project; and 2) **Financing Authority Resolution No. 2010-001** a) authorizing the deemed reissuance for federal tax purposes of the Allocable Bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$10,000,000; and b) authorizing the officers of the Authority to take certain actions in connection therewith.
