**SUBJECT:** RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A ONE HOUR PARKING TIME ZONE ON A  
PORTION OF S STREET

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

S Street from 13<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> Streets. Council District 4.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to establish a one hour parking time zone on S Street from 13<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> Streets.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends that a one hour parking time zone be established on S Street between 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Streets (Exhibit A). Regulating parking on this street will relieve the parking congestion generated by all day commuter parkers and provide additional customer parking for businesses.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- Parking is currently unregulated on S Street between 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Streets.
- Businesses along this portion of S Street have requested that the City establish a one hour parking time limit.
- A one hour parking time limit will relieve the parking congestion caused by all day commuter parkers and provide additional street parking for customers.
- There was no opposition to this proposal.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$200 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.



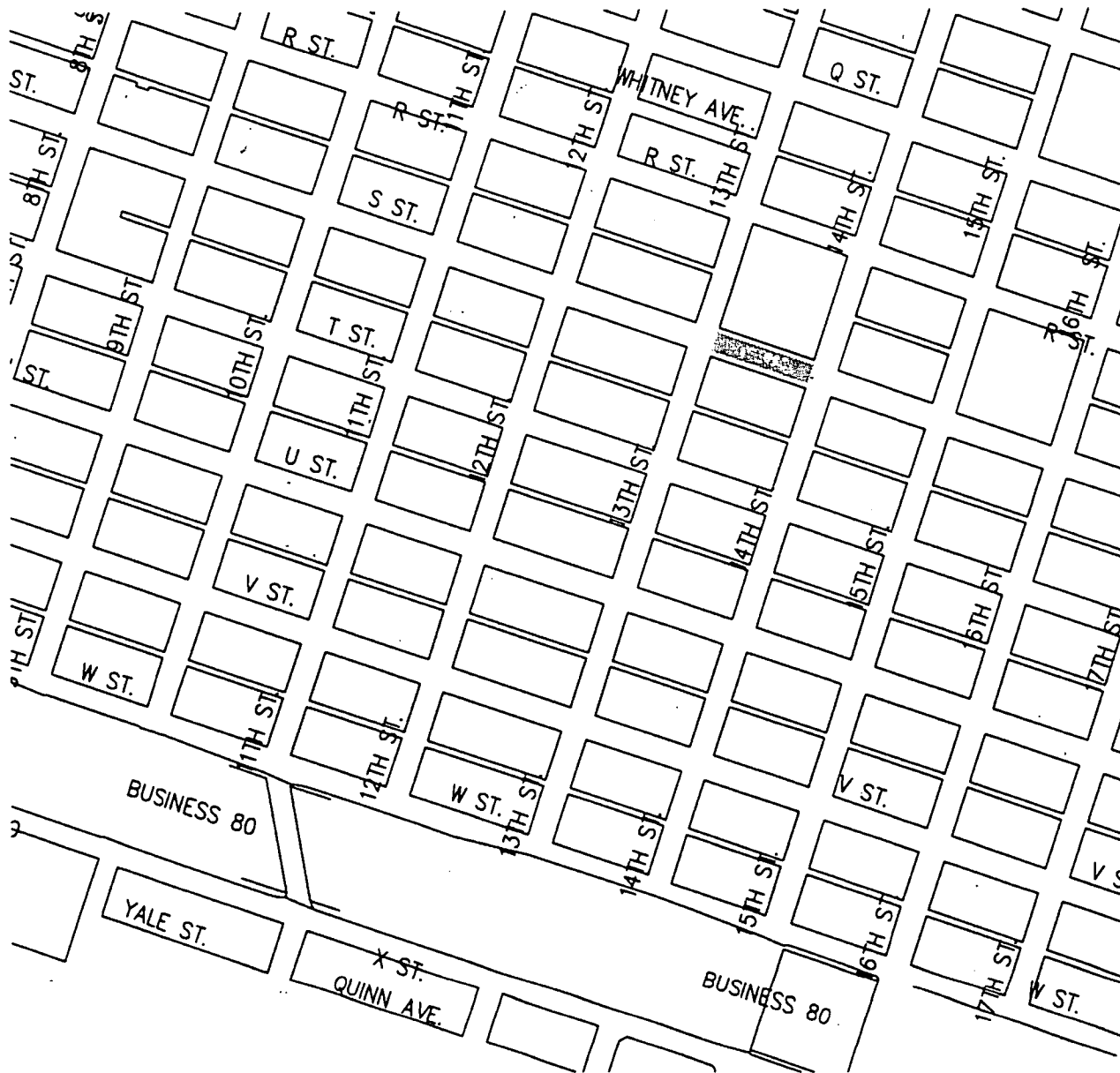

## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ONE HOUR PARKING TIME ZONE

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 25.07.109 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs have been placed giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle in a business district or on streets designated by resolutions during the days and hour indicated on such signs for a period of time longer than specified on such signs.

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

The following street shall be regulated with one-hour parking from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. except Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays:

- S Street, south side, from 13<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> Streets.
