SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ANNEXING A PORTION OF SUTTERVILLE ROAD, BABICH AVENUE, AND ARGAIL WAY TO THE LAND PARK/CITY COLLEGE RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Sutterville Road from Freeport Boulevard to Marion Court, Babich Avenue from Sutterville Road to Argail Way and Argail Way from Babich Avenue to Freeport Boulevard. Council District 4.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to annex Sutterville Road from Freeport Boulevard to Marion Court, Babich Avenue from Sutterville Road to Argail Way and Argail Way from Babich Avenue to Freeport Boulevard into the Land Park/City College residential permit parking area.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends annexing a portion of Sutterville Road, Babich Avenue, and Argail Way into the Land Park/City College residential permit parking area (Exhibit A). These streets will be regulated with a one hour parking time limit seven days a week from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Regulating parking on these streets will relieve the parking congestion generated by City College students and park users making it easier for residents to park near their homes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The Land Park/City College residential permit parking area was established in June 1991.
- Parking congestion is increasing on some streets adjacent to the permit parking area and residents are having difficulty parking near their homes.
- Residents along a portion of Sutterville Road, Babich Avenue, and Argail Way have requested to be annexed into the residential permit parking area.
- The annexed street will be regulated with a one hour parking time limit.
- Residents and their guests will be exempt from the parking time limit when the proper permit is displayed.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$200 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301c of the CEQA guidelines.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:





**A RESOLUTION ANNEXING A PORTION OF CERTAIN STREETS TO THE
LAND PARK/CITY COLLEGE RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 25.10.186 of the Sacramento City Code, whenever the City Council finds that residential streets adjacent to a residential permit parking area have all day, on-street parking congestion, then upon recommendation of the Parking Manager, such residential streets may be added to said residential permit parking area.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The following street shall be regulated with one-hour parking except with "L" permit from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.:

- Sutterville Road, south side, from Freeport Boulevard to Marion Court.
- Babich Avenue, both sides, from Sutterville Road to Argail Way.
- Argail Way, both sides, from Babich Avenue to Freeport Boulevard.
