

ORDINANCE NO. 1575, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE VARIOUS ITEMS OF LUMBER AND BUILDING MATERIALS TO BE USED IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TRACTOR AND TOOL SHED AT THE BING MALONEY GOLF COURSE, IN THE OPEN MARKET WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase in the open market, without advertising for bids various items of lumber and building materials to be used in the construction of a tractor and tool shed at the Bing Maloney Golf Course, from the following Sacramento firms:

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate need of said lumber and building materials for the completion of said Tractor and Tool Shed at the Bing Maloney Golf Course.
