

ORDINANCE NO. 1141, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE PROPERTY FROM THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase from the Surplus Property Division of the United States Government for the sum of \$10,571.<sup>80</sup>, the following:


- (a) Two (2) Gas engine driven Air Compressors approximately 105 cu. ft.
- (b) One (1) Ditching Machine, ladder type, crawler mounted, approximate digging depth 8 feet, approximate width 24",

without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the above items are needed immediately by the City.
