

ORDINANCE NO. 1623, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBDIVISION 5 OF SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 669, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 27, 1935, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF DANCING IN PLACES WHERE LIQUORS ARE SOLD, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 317, THIRD SERIES, PASSED OCTOBER 11, 1917; AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Subdivision 5 of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 669, Fourth Series, passed June 27, 1935, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Subdivision 5: The area bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of Stockton Boulevard and 10th Avenue, and thence proceeding easterly along the center line of 10th Avenue to a point 170 feet east of the center line of Stockton Boulevard, and thence proceeding along a line in a southerly direction and parallel with Stockton Boulevard to the south property line of San Francisco Boulevard; thence easterly to the point where San Francisco Boulevard intersects 50th Street, and thence southerly along a straight line 300 feet to the point which intersects Stockton Boulevard; thence northerly along the easterly line of Stockton Boulevard to the southerly boundary of 14th Avenue; thence westerly to a point 190 feet westerly from the center line of Stockton Boulevard, and thence proceeding in a northerly direction and parallel with Stockton Boulevard to the center line of 10th Avenue; thence easterly along the center line of 10th Avenue to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of changing the district in Subdivision 5 to include the property at 4217 Stockton Boulevard, Sacramento, California, and to promote the public welfare.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within 10 days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
