**SUBJECT: AMEND THE FY98-99 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM, TRANSFER FUNDS, AND AWARD THE CONTRACT TO ENVIRONMENTAL CONSTRUCTION FOR THE S/T ALLEY SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT (PN: XM74) FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$104,832**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

The project is located in the S/T alley between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Street (District 4).

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the City Council :

- Approve the attached resolution to amend FY98-99 Capital Improvement Program to add a new project;
- Transfer funds from the Combined System Reserve to the S/T Alley Sewer Replacement - 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> Street Project (PN: XM74);
- Award contract to Environmental Construction for an amount not to exceed \$104,832.

**SUMMARY**

A new Capital Improvement Project is needed due to the failure of the sewer main and deteriorated roadway surface. Bids for the S/T Alley Sewer Replacement - 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> Street Project were received from nine (9) contractors and opened by City Clerk on March 31, 1999. Environmental Construction was the lowest responsible bidder at \$104,832.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION**

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

This project was created to replace a deteriorated sewer main and to address depressions on the alley's concrete roadway. This project was advertised and bids were received on March 31, 1999 and are summarized below:

• Environmental Construction	\$104,832
• Navajo Pipelines, Inc.	\$105,195
• Sierra National Construction	\$112,570
• CON-STAR	\$114,337
• Biondi Paving	\$114,960
• Q.B.C. Paving	\$118,960
• Florez Paving	\$121,720
• Civil Engineering Construction	\$122,045
• Jaeger Construction	\$128,414

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS**

The estimated total project cost, including construction, inspection, and contingency is \$143,000. Staff recommends that the FY98-99 Capital Improvement Program be amended to add the S/T Alley Sewer Replacement - 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> Street Project (414/425-500-XM74-4820), and transfer funds from the Combined System Reserve (414/425-500-XD42-4414). As of April 16, 1999, the Combined Sewer System Reserve has an unobligated balance of \$1,274,566.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS**

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from CEQA under Section 1530(b) and 15302(c) of the CEQA Guidelines.

**POLICY CONSIDERATION**


The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code Title 58.

This project included participation goals of 20% for emerging and small business enterprises (ESBE) as required by Ordinance 99-007 and Resolution 99-055, relating to ESBE participation goals and policies, adopted by the City Council on February 9, 1999. The low bidder, Environmental Construction, exceeded ESBE goals with a participation level of 74%.



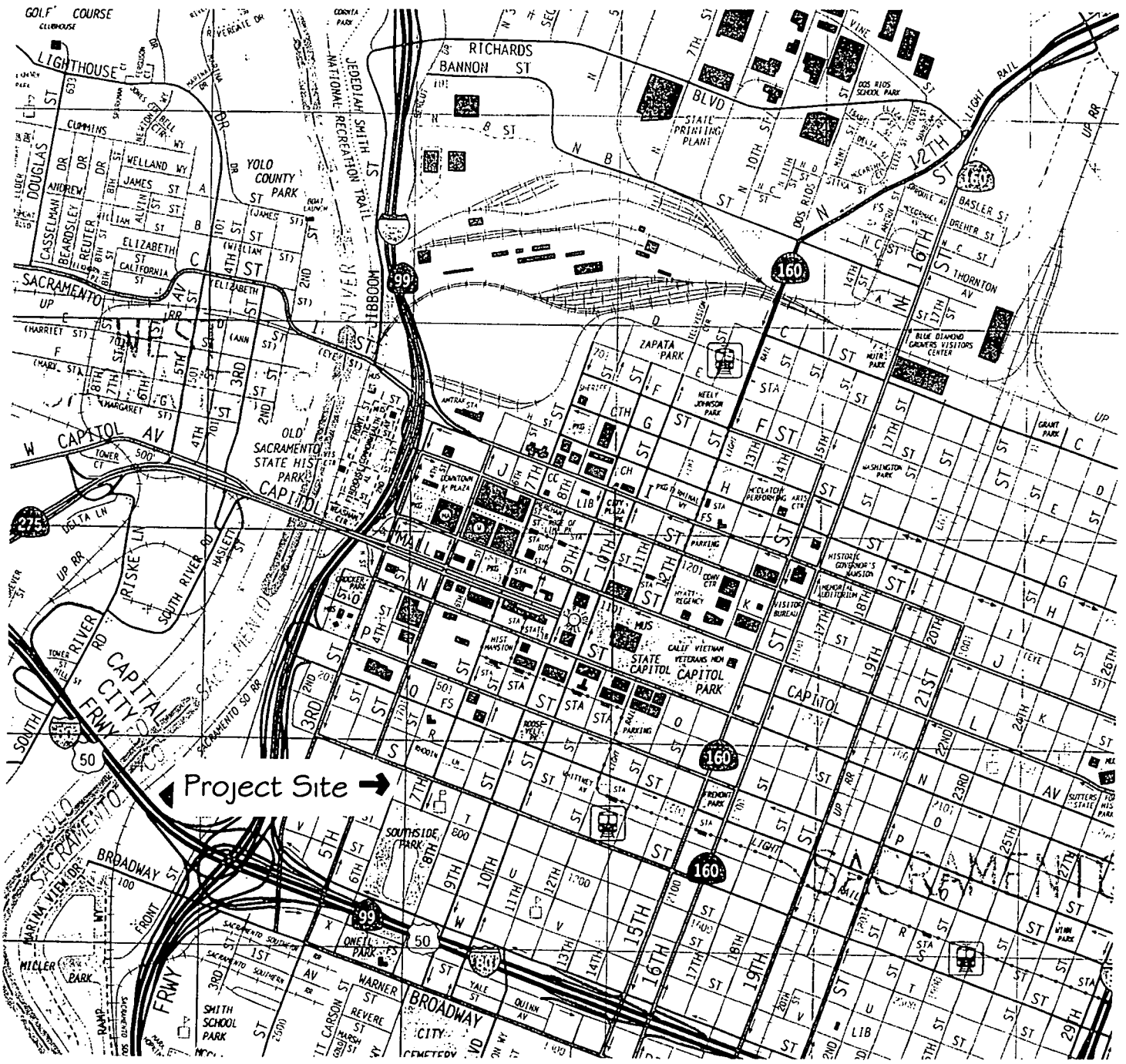

3. The City Manager and City are authorized to sign and execute a construction contract with Environmental Construction for an amount not to exceed \$104,832.
