

SPECIAL MEETING  
SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL  
August 10, 1965

The Honorable City Council met in Special Session on this date at the hour of 8:35 o'clock a. m., Mayor McKinney presiding and roll call was answered as follows:

Councilmen Christensen, Marriott, McKinney, Mering, Nielsen, Talkin.

ABSENT: Councilmen Domich, Rouse.

Executed copies of the call of the meeting issued by the Mayor and presented by the City Clerk, were ordered filed.

The call stated the purpose of the meeting to be that of considering and acting upon requests for allocations from the Entertainment and Advertising Fund.

Mayor McKinney requested the City Clerk to read aloud the following Section of the City Charter:

Sec. 80. ENTERTAINMENT FUND: The Council may appropriate and spend money from the funds of the City for any or all of the following purposes: Reception and entertainment of public guests, assistance of public celebrations held by the City at large, to aid or carry on the work of inducing immigration to the City, to exhibit manufactured and other products of the City; and generally, for the purpose of advertising the City, provided, however, that the aggregate expenditures for all of said purposes shall not exceed in one fiscal year the sum of two (2) cents on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of the assessed value of property within the City.

The City Clerk furnished each Councilman with a list of requests for allocations from the 1965-66 Entertainment and Advertising Fund, requests being:

Following discussion of the two foregoing requests, Council with Mayor McKinney's comments that support of Jr. Achievement in Sacramento and the sponsorship of a hydroplane were not appropriate type activities for City support and therefore did not qualify for consideration for allocations from the Entertainment and Advertising Fund.
