NOVEMBER 5TH, 1964


WHEREAS, petitions have been filed with the City Council requesting that proceedings be adopted for the ~~improvement~~ ~~work~~ construction of Storm Drainage and Sanitary Sewer Systems, Pumping Stations, reconstructing levees and all necessary appurtenances for the above described improvements in the real property described as follows:

All that portion of Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11, Township 7 North, Range 4 East, M. D. B. & M., described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Reclamation District No. 673; thence from said point of beginning northerly along the easterly boundary of said Reclamation District No. 673 to the northwesterly corner of lands now or formally owned by Mildred Freeburg, as described by Deed recorded in Book 3121 of Official Records, page 413; thence along the northerly line of said Freeburg property to the most northerly corner thereof; thence North $36^{\circ} 21'$ West 469.64 feet; thence North $30^{\circ} 12'$ East 342.30 feet; thence North $89^{\circ} 54' 30''$ East 1913.81 feet to the northwest corner of Rio Park, as shown on the official plat thereof, recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County in Book 25 of Maps, Map No. 11; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of said Rio Park to the center line of Pocket Road, formerly known as Riverside Boulevard; thence easterly along the center line of said Riverside Boulevard to the westerly right of way line of the Southern Pacific Railway Company; thence southerly along said westerly right of way line to the northeast corner of that certain tract of land described as Parcel No. 2 in the Final Order of Condemnation, City of Sacramento Vs Cora J. Klotz and Gene L. Klotz, a certified copy of which is recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County in Book 4163 of Official Records at page 897; thence along the boundary of the property of the City of Sacramento westerly and southerly to the northwest corner of that certain tract of land described as Parcel No. 1 in the deed executed by Cora J. Klotz and Gene L. Klotz, Executrix and Executor respectively of the estate of Louis George Klotz, deceased, to the County of Sacramento recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County in Book 3210 of Official Records at page 379; thence southerly along the westerly line of said County of Sacramento Property to the left or north bank of the Sacramento River; thence upstream along the left or north bank of the Sacramento River following the meanderings thereof to the point of beginning,
