

RESOLUTION ORDERING OMISSION OF WORK SPECIFIED  
BY RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF LEGISLATIVE BODY  
TO CHANGE WORK NO. 2525.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento did on the 18th day of January 1946, adopt its Resolution of Intention of Legislative Body to change work No. 2525, wherein it was the findings of this Council that the public interest, convenience and necessity does not require the improvement of the

Pedestrian Lane which lies between  
Lots 80 and 81, and Lots 64 and 65 in  
said Tahoe Terrace Unit No.1, by re-  
moving and disposing of all refuse and  
surplus material and constructing con-  
crete sidewalk five (5) feet in width.

WHEREAS, this Council has heretofore ordered that the hearing should be held on the 8th day of February 1946, and

WHEREAS, it appears from the affidavit of the City Clerk of this Council that notices of said hearing has been duly and legally given in the time, form, and manner as provided in the "Improvement Act of 1911", approved June 7th, 1911, and the several acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, now therefore the City Council finds and determines that the hearing upon the Resolution of Intention of Legislative Body to change work has been held upon the 8th day of February, 1946 at the hour of eight (8) p.m. in the Council Chambers of
