**SUMMARY:**

The Tahoe Park and Colonial Heights neighborhoods have worked together with Planning and Neighborhood Services staff to develop a consensus vision and a plan that reflects their common goals and priorities. The result of this collaboration is the attached Strategic Neighborhood Action Plan or SNAP. Its purpose is to guide the neighborhood, the City and others in planning and other decision-making actions for these two East Broadway area neighborhoods over the next five years. Since it is their neighborhood plan, the Tahoe/Colonial neighborhood leadership will oversee the implementation strategy and monitoring of the recommended actions with assistance and in partnership with the Area 3 Neighborhood Services Office. This effort was also the pilot for a community-based planning approach, which the Planning Department is
