

ORDINANCE NO. 1086, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE DISTRICTS ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1000, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED DECEMBER 14, 1943, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE USE OF PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; PROVIDING FOR ITS ENFORCEMENT; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The territory hereinafter described and which was heretofore classified as Two-Family, Multiple Family and Retail Districts and "A" and "E" Height and Area Districts, is hereby reclassified to Commercial District and "F" Height and Area District:

The west eighteen (18) feet of Lot 104 and all of Lots Nos. 105, 106, 107, 108 and 120 of J. C. Carly "Casita Subdivision";

All of Lots Nos. 109 and 110 of J. C. Carly "Casita Subdivision";

That tract of land lying between the easterly line of Alhambra Boulevard and the westerly line of 32nd Street from the southerly line of Casita Way to the northerly line of commercial district, lying north of Stockton Boulevard and per Use District Map of the City of Sacramento, adopted by the City Council by Ordinance No. 1000, Fourth Series, December 14, 1943.

SECTION 2: The City Clerk of the City of Sacramento is hereby directed to change the maps which are a part of said Ordinance No. 1000, Fourth Series, to conform to the provisions of the Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is passed and adopted pursuant to and after the publication of notice thereof and hearing held in accordance with provisions provided by Ordinance No. 1000, Fourth Series, and the general law.
