SUBJECT: County of Sacramento FY 1990-91 Funding Support - Sacramento Museum
and History Division, Metropolitan Arts Division, Sacramento Sports
Commission

SUMMARY

This report requests authorization to execute agreements with the County of Sacramento for their FY 1990-1991 support of the Sacramento Museum and History Commission, Sacramento History Museum, Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission, and Sacramento Sports Commission.

BACKGROUND

The Sacramento Museum and History Commission, Sacramento History Center, Sacramento Science Center, Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission, and the Sacramento Sports Commission are supported through joint City-County efforts. Each year, the City and County approve the budgets of these organizations, appropriating funds in the City budget, a portion of which is reimbursed by the County of Sacramento.

The approved city 1990-1991 fiscal year budget includes county support of:

\$234,825	Sacramento Museum and History Commission
\$196,913	Sacramento History Museum
\$101,015	Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission
\$ 25,000	Sacramento Sports Commission

The allocation for the Museum and History Commission includes operational support and half of the debt service and custodial costs for the Museum and History Division office building.

An agreement between the City and County for each organization is necessary to facilitate this funding support. The agreements reflect the above amounts.

FINANCIAL DATA

Funding support from the County of Sacramento to the Sacramento Museum and History Commission, Sacramento History Museum, Sacramento Sports Commission, and Metropolitan Arts Commission has been included in the city budget for the 1990-91 fiscal year.



RECOMMENDATION


